RE: Arkansas Medicolegal Death Investigator Certification Course

The Coroners' Continuing Education Board has planned a 40-hour Arkansas Medicolegal Death Investigator Certification Course to be held over two-weekends January 14-16 and January 22-23, 2022. The certification course will be held at the Hilton Garden Inn Little Rock Downtown, 322 Rock St., Little Rock/Pulaski County. Classroom instruction will begin at 8:00 a.m. and will end at approximately 5:00 p.m. each day.
